Howard Park Museum Release Riesling 2012 78

GREAT SOUTHERN, WA

Crystalline, pale lime yellow in colour with intense and lifted aromas of freshly zested lemon/lime. The palate is full of fresh citrus, nashi pear and green apple flavours give depth and richness. A fine, mineral and citrus acidity with dryness adds length of finish.

Tyrrell's Vat 1 Semillon 2013 150

HUNTER VALLEY, NSW

A classic Hunter Valley semillon with a green/gold colour similar to previous years with a rich, intense palate of fruit and a backbone of clean, fresh acid.

Petaluma Piccadilly Valley Chardonnay 2017 108

PICCADILLY VALLEY, SA

Delicate, full flavoured complex dry wine. Clean bright white peach and nectarine aromas are backed up by a wonderful creamy mouth-feel, lovely natural acidity contributes great complexity and length.

Moss Wood Chardonnay 2018 140

MARGARET RIVER, WA

The initial impact is of generous ripe fruits, full body and smooth texture. There are generous peach, marmalade and roast almond flavours, sitting over a balanced astringency that builds the mouthfeel but doesn't impinge on the texture, so gives the wine a long, sweet, round feel.

Helen's Hill 'Range View' Reserve Pinot Noir 2016 98

YARRA VALLEY, VIC

This single vineyard & clone one is predominantly loamy clay on a limestone / ironstone base. The firm, powerful and dusty tannins with meaty flavour of smoke and game with notes of soil. More depth and concentration.

Chard Farm 'Mark II' Pinot Noir 2012 130

CENTRAL OTAGO, NZ

Initially quite spicy on the nose with intense perfume of berry fruit & wild flower. Very fine tannins fill the mouth and push the sinewy red fruits to the back of the palate with an elegant mineral acid tail. The wine finishes with considerable energy and drive.

Lowe Zinfandel 2015 MUDGE, NSW 120

This Organic wine has dark ruby in colour, plum cake, liquorice and prune bouquet with a viscous, soft, lingering finish on the palate.

Henschke Keyneton Euphonium 2014 EDEN VALLEY, SA 140

75% SHIRAZ, 11% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 8% MERLOT & 6% CABERNET FRANC

An intense nose of dark forest fruits, plums, dried herbs, cassis and cedar.

The palate is lush and rich, showing bright fruit characters, nice texture with velvety tannins with long finish.

Glaetzer Amon-Ra Unfiltered Shiraz 2017 150

BAROSSA VALLEY, SA

The key to Amon-Ra Shiraz is balancing the extraction, rather than maximising it. Darkly concentrated and rich yet maintaining poise and freshness. It displays masses of dark fruit and spice on the nose and an alluring depth & structure on the palate.

Katnook Odyssey Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 180

COONAWARRA, SA

This has always been an iconic wine, and the bright crimson colour is a great start, quickly followed by beautifully pitched cassis/blackcurrant fruit and finely shaped tannins in perfect balance. There's not much to say about this wine, so perfect is the balance and mouthfeel.

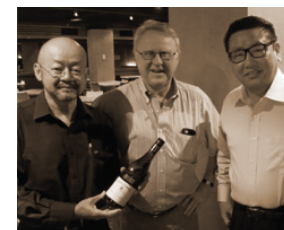
Torbreck 'The Factor' Shiraz 2005 BAROSSA VALLEY, SA 240

It is based around a blend of a few small parcels of ancient and dry grown Shiraz vineyards is the northern sub-regions of the Barossa Valley, some as old as 170 years. It is rich and full bodied, textural and fruit driven with only a hint of new oak to support the luscious fruit flavours and weight derived from these beautiful old vineyards.
